### **Decision details**

2. Mr Broadhead may not practise on his own account under regulation 10.2(a) or (b) of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations.

### **Reasons/basis**

They are reasonable and proportionate having regard to the purposes set out in regulation 7 of the SRA Authorisation of Individuals Regulations, and the regulatory objectives and principles governing regulatory activities as contained in section 28 of the Legal Services Act 2007.
